### **CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

#### **GENERAL**

- Events will be played according to the Laws of the Sport 2004.
- All competitions will be straight knock-out.
- Entry fee is \$10.00 per person per event.
- Games will be played Saturday and Sunday as shown on the schedule. The games for the next Saturday and Sunday will be displayed on Monday. If you are unable to play in the session in which you have been drawn, please find a spare (not applicable for singles) or inform the manager as soon as possible so that an alternate match may be scheduled.
- A spare must be a club member who has not entered the competition in which they are sparing.
- A member who spares in 2 consecutive games for the same team member becomes the official team member.
- All singles games will be 21 points.
- All other events will be 18 ends or the time limit of the session, whichever comes first.

#### **MEN'S & WOMEN'S CLUB SINGLES**

The players scheduled to play are responsible to provide their own marker.

#### **MEN'S HANDICAP SINGLES**

A handicap will be applied to members depending upon their rating.

A 1-rated member must score 21 shots	A 3-rated member must score 17 shots
A 2-rated member must score 19 shots	A 4-rated members must score 15 shots

The players scheduled to play are responsible to provide their own marker.

#### **MEN'S, MIXED PAIRS and DONEVAN WOMEN'S PAIRS**

Members will enter as a team.

#### **MEN'S 5 STAR PAIRS**

Members will enter as a team.

The combined ratings of the two players must total at least 5 (e.g., a 1 rated member must partner with a 4 rated member).

#### **MEN'S, WOMEN'S AND MIXED TRIPLES AND FOURS; WOMEN'S CENTENNIAL PAIRS**

Members will enter as individuals and teams will be drawn so that the teams will be as even as possible.

Once teams have been drawn, they may arrange themselves to play in whatever positions they wish.

A spare should have the same rating as the person whose place they are taking.

A spare may not skip.
